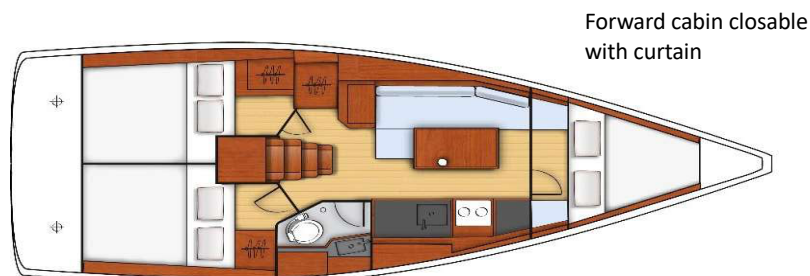

Cabins/Galley:

Forward cabin closable with curtain (no rigid bulkhead or door) - Gas cooker with 2 burners – Oven – Refrigerator with freezer – Sink with hot/cold water – Kitchen utensils, plates, glasses, cutlery, coffee makers, pots & pans – 2 Italian espresso coffee makers – Wooden spoons – Grater – Lemon squeezer – Containers – Bottle opener – Salad bowls – Thermos – Tablecloth - Fans in cabin and dinette - Pillows – Blankets – Bed linen – Towels
